

We play the banjo as well as make it; we do not remain indifferent and separate, but become part of our work.


Series "Thirty"; Grade 1 Only

Specifications

NECK

The necks are laminated Peruvian mahogany and maple woods with five vertical and two horizontal laminations to increase strength and insure against warping. The neck is so constructed that the grain of the individual lamina are in opposition with each other which also aids stability. A hand rubbed, natural finish is used to bring out the full beauty of the wood.

An adjustable tension bar is incorporated to counter balance string tension and compensate for climatic changes.



RESONATOR

The resonator has a curved mahogany back with non-warpable aluminum sides. It can be installed on any model and can be easily removed at any time.








The fingerboard is Brazilian rosewood with mother-of-pearl position dots and nickel silver frets. There are also corresponding position dots inlayed on the side of the fingerboard.

Either side tuning Grover rotomatics (12:1 gear ratio) or vertical pegs (2:1 gear ratio) are available.

A NON-SLIP FIFTH-STRING PEG WITH A METAL KNOB IS STANDARD ON ALL 5-STRING INSTRUMENTS.



Your choice of a scroll or square type peghead is available on all models.

RIM

The truly unique feature of the Ode banjo is the rim which is cast aluminum, machined and




ALUMINUM RIM

polished. It will not warp and since the finish is produced by a polishing of the rim itself, there is no superficial surface to flake or chip off. It has the advantage of

wood, being light, and possesses that ringing quality inherent only in metal.

The series "thirty" rim (style A) has a flat top with our perforated tone chamber construction. A heavy notched tension hoop, armrest, two way adjustable inertia tailpiece (all chrome plated) and 28 brackets (nickel plated) are standard.

We have found that the plastic head is best for all around banjo playing. It gives a clear, sharp sound, and is not affected by humidity. However, for those who prefer a more mellow tone, calfskin is available at no extra cost.

A three legged ebony, maple, and bone bridge; elastic capo; bracket and tension rod wrenches are standard on all instruments.

Specifications

NECK

Ode series "forty" banjo necks are laminated with seven vertical and three horizontal laminations and all have an ebony fingerboard.

RIM

Three rim styles are available on any series "forty" instrument. Each style has an aluminum base with a bell brass tone chamber which gives the instrument improved bass, cleaner tone qualities, and more response throughout the entire playing range.

STYLE B—FLAT TOP, designed for the sharp, stacatto response characteristic of bluegrass and fingerpicking styles.

STYLE F—FLAT TOP, designed for the smooth, mellow qualities of frailing and similar strumming styles.

STYLE R—ARCHED TOP, for crisp qualities in tone and response.


